

**Mission Statement:** The mission of CREPAC is to administer bipartisan political expenditures, on behalf of the REALTOR® PARTY OF CALIFORNIA, to advance homeownership and protect private property rights. CREPAC supports local, state and federal candidates who uphold the values of democracy and Fair Housing laws.

**Committee Purpose:** CREPAC State Trustees evaluate candidates for state elected office (e.g. Assembly, Senate, Governor, etc.) and decide on an appropriate level of support, if any. It is the duty of the CREPAC Trustees to make the ultimate determination as to who is best for the state as a whole.

EPAC and LCRC support candidate campaigns in California.

Voluntary contributions from members fund the California Real Estate PAC (CREPAC), which supports candidates for state level office. Local Associations may direct funds from CREPAC to the campaigns of local level office seekers through their Local Candidate Recommendation Committee (LCRC).

Support from CREPAC is directed to candidates for public office who understand the importance of REALTOR® issues and who will take positions on those issues that help promote the cause of housing and private property rights.

The Issues Mobilization PAC (IMPAC) is the issues advocacy arm of C.A.R.'s political action committee structure. The political action committee is funded by member contributions and is used exclusively to support advocacy efforts on behalf of real estate and housing in California. These funds are used for issues advocacy only. No candidate activities are funded with IMPAC dollars.

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
