### Message from the President - Dee

Today I'm sharing "Valuable Tips" I learned from other quilters:

White chalk quilting marks that refuse to come off after you **pressed** the quilt top. Oops! Not to worry, a dab of white vinegar on a piece of muslin will rub it off!

Finished quilting my piece when I discovered a seam came apart and it was so scant, I could not applique it closed. Solution: slip a tiny piece of fusible between seams and iron to close. It works!

Need only a 3" x 2" piece to finish a project, and there is absolutely no more fabric anywhere.

If you have printable sheets and a scanner, scan a piece and voila! You have an 8.5" x 11" piece to work with. Might not be exact, but no one will notice that small piece that's a bit different.

And, of course, the most valuable lesson from all the above, is don't despair, don't panic, it can all be fixed and it will be alright!! Good lesson for quilting, good lesson for life.

### Service Committee Report - Ginny, Chair

- Dee has batting for our donated quilts. Contact her before the Sunday meeting and she'll bring what you need to the meeting.
- Mary will be printing off labels for our different types of quilts.
- Sandy has given us some more information about the Texture Quilts. These are in addition to the ones we've been making, not to replace them, but to give us even more options. This type is more specifically to be used with wheel chairs.

#### Description for this new type of lap quilt:

The quilt is 24 inches wide by 36 inches long with two 6 inch ties on each side of the top with velcro sewn onto the ties. The ties can then loop around the wheel chair hardware and then velcroed together in order to hold the quilt in place on the lap. Pockets should be sewn on so that they open up, depending on which 24 inch side you decide is the top (the velcro ties are on the top). Buttons and lace and or any embellishment like rick rack strips or ruffles may be added. Remember we call them Texture or Touch Quilts because of those nice variations in the feel of the quilt.

- Finally Sew 'n Sew has new "Printable fabric" for labels and such.
