### Treasurer Report-Sharon L.

The club currently has a total of \$12,186. A donation of \$290 was received from making a memorial quilt and \$500 will be paid to Lions Hall for the retreat.

Insurance purchase – The club approved and voted on purchasing insurance from Southern California Council of Quilt Guilds. The cost is \$40 a year plus \$3.25 per member, per year. This item was not budgeted for this year but will be added to the future budgets.

### Brown Bag Challenge-Tina P

Packets for The Brown Bag Challenge will be available at the October Retreat and at November meeting. The items made from these packets are to be presented at the Tea in April and are due by March 31, 2018.

They will be given to children in the emergency room and siblings of newborns receiving our Warm Welcome quilts. The club will need to fund the money for items in the bags of a budget of \$200 per year. Presented to club and approved for this year and to add to next year's budget.
