Antenna, worker housing at PA before planning commission

Music festival near Piercy wants to expand to 8,000 attendees, renew permit for five years

The Mendocino County Planning Commission will consider a new radio tower at the Point Arena Lighthouse, housing for farm workers near Manchester, and a permit for a music festival near Piercy at its June 7 meeting.

The Walter Stornetta Ranch and Del Mar farms are proposing two new units of housing for farm workers on a .78-acre parcel about a mile south of Manchester. The project would replace an existing 400-square-foot mobile home, a travel trailer, and two sheds with a 1,944-square-foot duplex. The new unit would be reconnected to existing utilities.

Point Arena Lighthouse Keepers are proposing to upgrade their existing radio antenna to meet industry standards of 800 megahertz, "critical for ensuring public and employee safety." The project would reach a maximum height of 16 feet (matching the existing antenna height) and provide coverage along Highway 1.

Northern Lights Music Festival is applying for

a land use permit starting Thursday, July 19, to end at midnight on Sunday, July 22. The location remains unchanged: 2.5 miles north of Piercy, just south of the Mendocino/Humboldt county line.

This event has been permitted for 6,000 people a day, for three days, since 2015. The applicant is asking for the permit to be renewed through 2022 for a four-day event and that the daily attendance limit be raised to 8,000 people.

County staff has recommended renewing the permit for three years instead of five, in order to follow standard county procedure of renewing events based on the original term. They noted that the California Department of Fish and Wildlife expressed concern about the effects of the event on the habitat of the protected foothill yellow-legged frog and the event's water connection to the Eel River. They also noted that Northern Nights Music Group has not made timely payments to the Mendocino County Sheriff's Office for services rendered at the past three years' events.
