Sharon G. reported that the large opportunity quilt is at the Community First CU for the month of January and raffle tickets are being sold. The small opportunity quilt is at Spunky Skunk. Both quilts will be on display January 17 at Presbyterian Church at a talk presented by Sharon L. The first Monday in February Sharon G. will have the quilts outside of Purity Market and when there are Festivals in town, special events etc., Sharon G. has procured a place in the Company Store.

Sharon L. presented information about the Quilt Walk. Most merchants can take a 20" X 20" quilt. We will need about 49 quilts. You can make a quilt, contribute a quilt that you have already made or make a quilt that reflects the show theme of "Magic Dreams". The "Magic Dreams" quilts will be judged that best reflects the theme. Library will need 3 large quilts, 60X60 with sleeve, and 10-12 small quilts. Hospital 9 -10 large quilts, with sleeve. These will be due at Sew 'n Sew by May 25 and will be returned early July. Reminder.... mark your quilt or sew a label with your name. Construction of the 2020 Opportunity Quilts will begin in February with the collection of fabric and instructions. Becky B. will be responsible for the Large Opportunity Quilt. Becky requested dark and medium, warm jewel tone colors, 3" X 42" or WOF strips. Daisy Woodhams will be responsible for the Small Opportunity Quilt. More info to follow.
