

MAKING THE FOX BLOCK

Follow these directions to make each fox block.

STEP 1 With right sides together, place two pieces C on top of piece A, aligning pieces C with the outside edges of piece A. Use a fabric marker to draw a diagonal line from corner to corner of each piece C, as shown in **Fig. 1**. Sew along the marked lines to create diagonal seams. Trim away the excess fabric to leave 1/4" seam allowances and press the seams open to finish the ear unit. (**Fig. 2**)

Some remaining steps will include diagonal seams. Use the same process from Step 1, referring to the diagrams for correct placement of the pieces and angles.

STEP 2 Sew together pieces F and G, creating 2 FG units as shown in **Fig. 3**. If using directional fabric, note that these units should be mirror images of one another. Refer to **Fig. 4** to see how they will be placed when sewn to Pieces I.

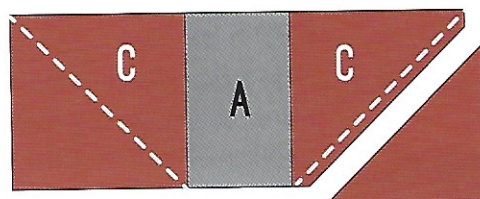
