**Quilt Show – Sherry**

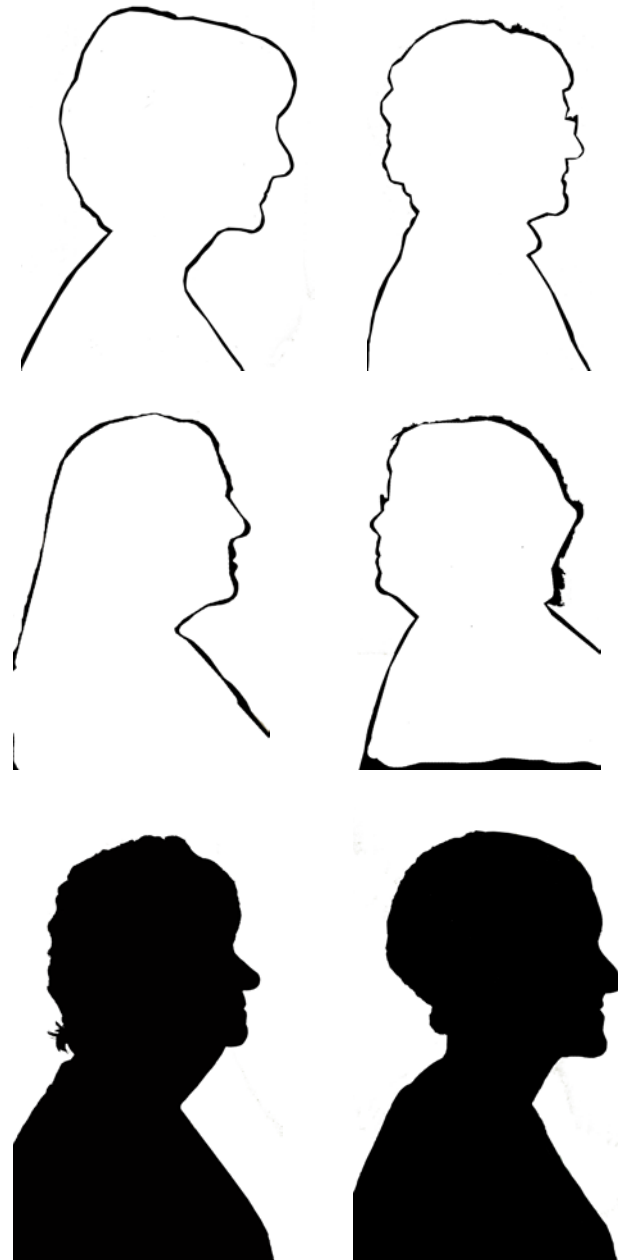
