Hospitality – Tina P.

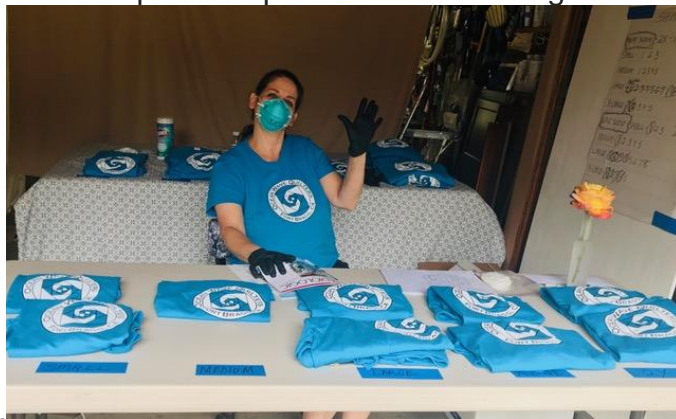

Kim R. captured a picture of Tina selling t-shirts

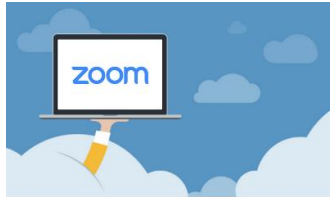


Senior Center Sewing Project - Cindi Jo W.
