

Fast and Simple Baby Strip Quilts (Using 22 coordinating 2½" by Width Of Fabric strips)

Super Simple Strip Quilt

(Approx. 43"x 43")

Step 1: Arrange your strips to a pleasing layout and sew pairs together. (1st strip to 2nd strip, 3rd strip to 4th strip, etc.)

Step 2: Sew the 1st pair to the 2nd pair, sew the 3rd pair to the 4th pair, etc. until you have sewn the pairs into sets of 4 strips each. (there will be one pair left).

Step 3: Sew the 1st set of 4 to the 2nd set of 4, etc. Add the left over pair from the last step to the end.

Step 5: Continue sewing sets together until all strips are sewn together.

Step 6: Press all seams in same direction. Trim sides.

Simple Strip Quilt

(Approx. 40"x 43")

Follow directions for Super Simple Strip Quilt above. Then:

Step 7: Measure, then cut at about 10" from one side of quilt. Set aside the 10" piece.

Step 8: From larger piece left over, measure and cut at about 6".

Step 9: For the quilt pictured, Separate the orange from the yellow, line up dark ends, stitch dark ends together.

Step 10: Sew the 6" piece to larger left over piece, then sew the 10" piece to the other side of the 6" piece.

Have fun with different colors, layouts and different widths of pieces! Keep in mind that for every section cut and sewn, your quilt will lose ½" in width.
