



STRIP BUTTERFLIES

1 cut

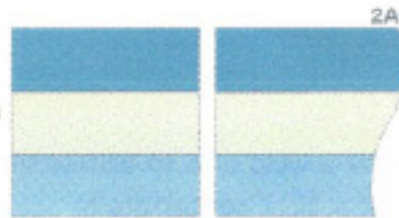
From the peach background fabric:



- Subcut the $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 20" strip into (8) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.
- The $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $14\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle will be trimmed to a $12\frac{1}{2}$ " length when the block is finished.

2 make strip sets

Choose 3 different strips from the roll and trim them to a 26" length OR cut 3 strips $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 26". Sew them together horizontally. Cut (4) $6\frac{1}{2}$ " squares from the strip set.

3 block construction

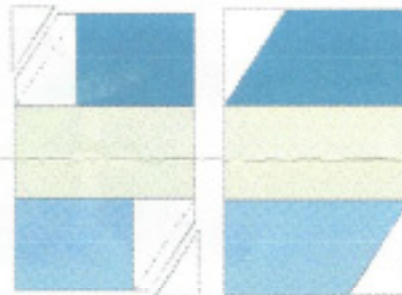
Fold (8) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " background squares once on the diagonal and press the crease in place. This will mark your sewing line. 3A

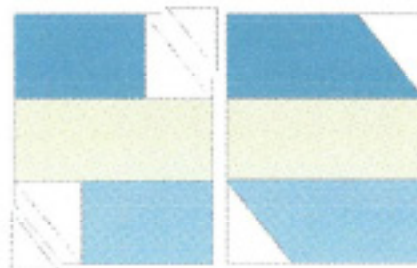
Place a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " background square on the upper left and lower right corner of a $6\frac{1}{2}$ " square with right sides facing. Stitch on the crease. Trim the excess fabric away $\frac{1}{4}$ " from the sewn seam. Make 2 units like this. 3B

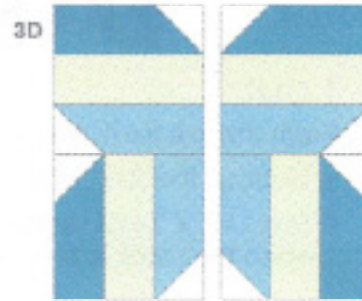

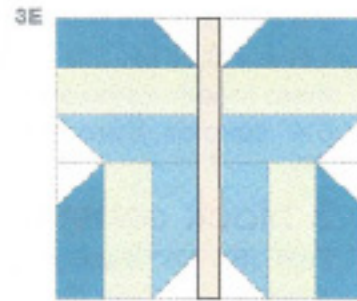
Place a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " background square on the upper right and lower left corner of a $6\frac{1}{2}$ " square with right sides facing. Stitch on the crease. Trim the excess fabric away $\frac{1}{4}$ " from the sewn seam. Make 2 units like this. 3C



Sew the units together as shown to make the left and right wings of the butterfly. 3D



Sew a wing unit to either side of a $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $12\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle to complete the block. 3E



Block Size: 13" x 12" finished
