

Web Coaster/Mug Rug

Have fun, share the pattern, copy in full exactly as is.

Materials Needed to make one 5-6" Coaster

Four different 1¼"x 18" Strips of coordinating fabric

7" square fabric for backing

7" square of batting

Ruler with a 60° line

To make it larger, just make the strip widths wider and longer



Instructions

A. Sew strips together along long edges. Press seams open

B & C. Find the 60° line on your ruler, then line it up with the edge of your strip set as shown. Make your first cut here.

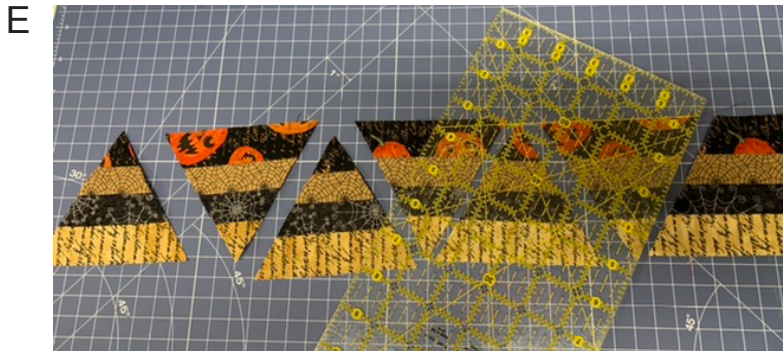
D. Line up the 60° line on your ruler with the cut line from step C to create your 1st triangle.



E. Continue cutting for a total of 6 triangles.

F. Lay out triangles with strips horizontal to outer edge, alternating the two different edges.

G. Sew 3 triangles together on each side, then sew the 2 sides together. As shown in H.



Cut batting and backing fabric to match web.

Layer as such:

Batting on the bottom

Web next, right side up

Backing next, face down, right sides together with web.

Pin together

Stitch $\frac{1}{4}$ " from edge, leaving a 2" opening between points.

Trim off points.

Turn right side out, press. *

To create the "web" shape as shown in J; Mark a dot $\frac{1}{4}$ " in from each point, draw a slightly curved line from dot to dot.

Sew on line, leaving a 2" opening between points. Trim off points, clip fabric along curves.

Turn right side out, press. *

*Stitch around coaster, about $\frac{1}{8}$ " from edge. This will also stitch the opening closed.

To quilt, stitch along seam lines, or as desired.





Stitch and Flip Mug Rug

Have fun, share the pattern,
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Materials Needed to make one 4½”x 8” Mug Rug

One 5”x 5¼” piece of focus fabric

Three different 3”x 7” Strips of coordinating fabric, with one edge cut on an angle.

One piece of 5”x 8½” fabric for backing

One piece of 5”x 8½” of batting

Pinking Shears or Pinking Rotary Blade

Instructions

Layer as such: Backing fabric, right side down, then batting, then focus fabric to one side so that the 5” fits on the 5” backing and batting.

Place straight edge of next fabric onto straight edge of focus fabric, right sides together. (A) Stitch along straight edge with ¼” seam allowance. Press piece open (B)

Place straight edge of next fabric onto straight edge of last fabric, right sides together. (C) Stitch along straight edge with ¼” seam allowance. Press piece open (D)

Place straight edge of next fabric onto straight edge of last fabric, right sides together. (E)
Stitch along straight edge with $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance. Press piece open (F)

Stitch a little more than $\frac{1}{4}$ " from edge completely around mug rug. Add more stitching/quilting if desired. Using a ruler as a guide cut off edges with a pinking blade. If using the rotary blade, cut with one solid movement or the edges will be fuzzy.
