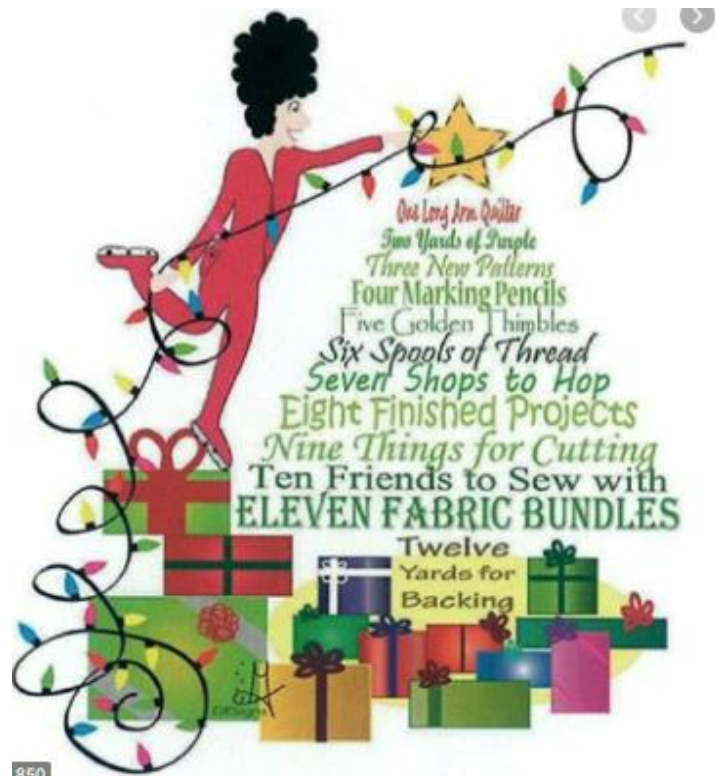

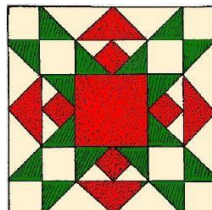

The one thing we could do is plan a little fun game (thanks for the push, Tina), so Nancy L. and I created a "Holiday Bingo" to play. See the instructions to make your simple card.

Thanks again to Sharon Lau for hosting Zoom so all I have to do is show up and have fun. Next practice: Monday, November 30 at 11:00 am

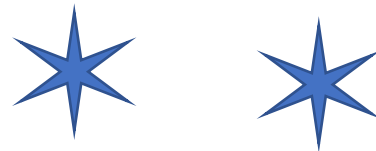
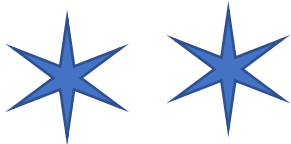


TIP OF THE MONTH

CLEAN your machine between quilt projects! It will save cleaning bills and minimize downtime.

I do the following:

- Remove the plate (it maybe in two pieces)
- Use a Microbrush to clean down and around everything you can reach. These brushes have a bit of stuff on the end and are flexible to pick up and bend into the nooks and crannies.
- I also “vacuum” out after every other project (or so). I have a small attachment that works on the end of my regular vacuum with a very small wand. Works nicely.



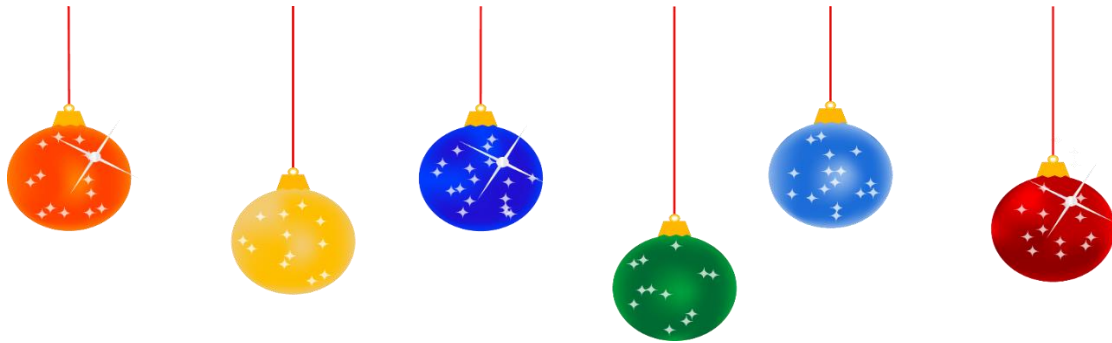

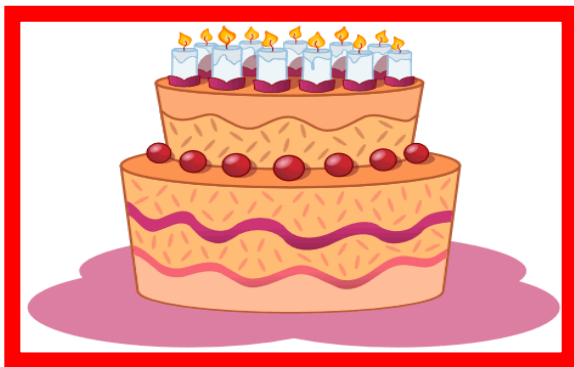
