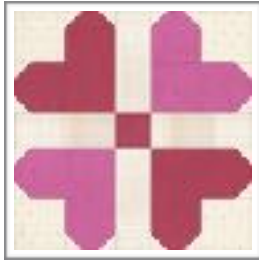


Blooming Valentines BOM 01/2021



The Bloomin' Valentine block measures 13 1/2" x 13 1/2" (including sashing)

(note the picture shows 2 1/2" sashing but I changed it 1 1/2")

Heart Unit (consists of 4 hearts plus sashing)

For each heart:

From the white:

Cut 4 squares at 1 1/2" (snowballs)

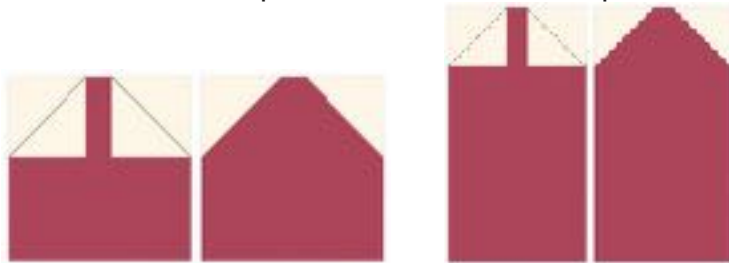
Cut 1 square at 3 1/2" (corner)

Use various prints that are valentine colors for the hearts.

Cut 1 piece at 3 1/2" x 6 1/2"

Cut 1 piece at 3 1/2" x 3 1/2"

Mark the wrong side of the white background 1 1/2" squares in half diagonally once. Place a marked square on the corner of a print 3 1/2" square as shown below.



Sew on the marked line, trim a 1/4" seam and press. Repeat on the opposite corner to make the short side of the heart unit.

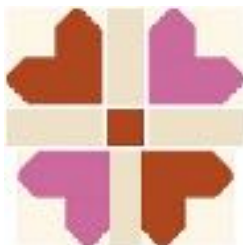
Repeat the same process as above on the 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangle to make the long side of the heart unit.



Lay a long and short side of the heart unit and a white background 3 1/2" out as shown below. Sew together to make a heart unit.

**The heart unit measures 6 1/2" x 6 1/2" unfinished.
Repeat to make 4 Heart Units.**

Block Assembly (sashing)



Cut 4 white pieces at 1 1/2" x 6 1/2" as sashing.

Cut 1 red piece (could be a print) at 1 1/2" square as a cornerstone.

Make a row by sewing a 1 1/2" x 6 1/2" strip between two hearts

Make a sashing row and add a 1 1/2" cornerstone in the middle

Sew the pieces together into three rows, and then sew the rows together.
