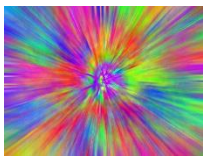

### TIP OF THE MONTH



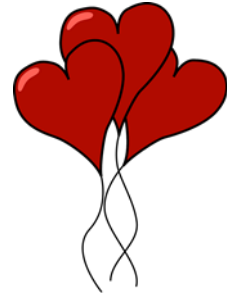
#### Back to Basics

Accurate cutting, pressing, ironing and straight/consistent stitching.  
Try this: cut 5 strips at  $2\frac{1}{2}$  X 6". Sew two strips together using a  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam. Measure the results. Do they measure  $4\frac{1}{2}$ ? Keep adding and measuring until all strips are sewn together. Do they measure  $12\frac{1}{2}$ "?

You might conclude that these tips will help make your points be more accurate!
