brought me to tears.

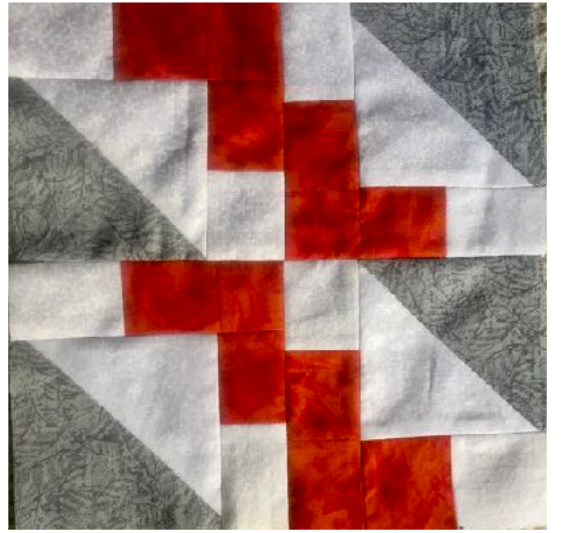

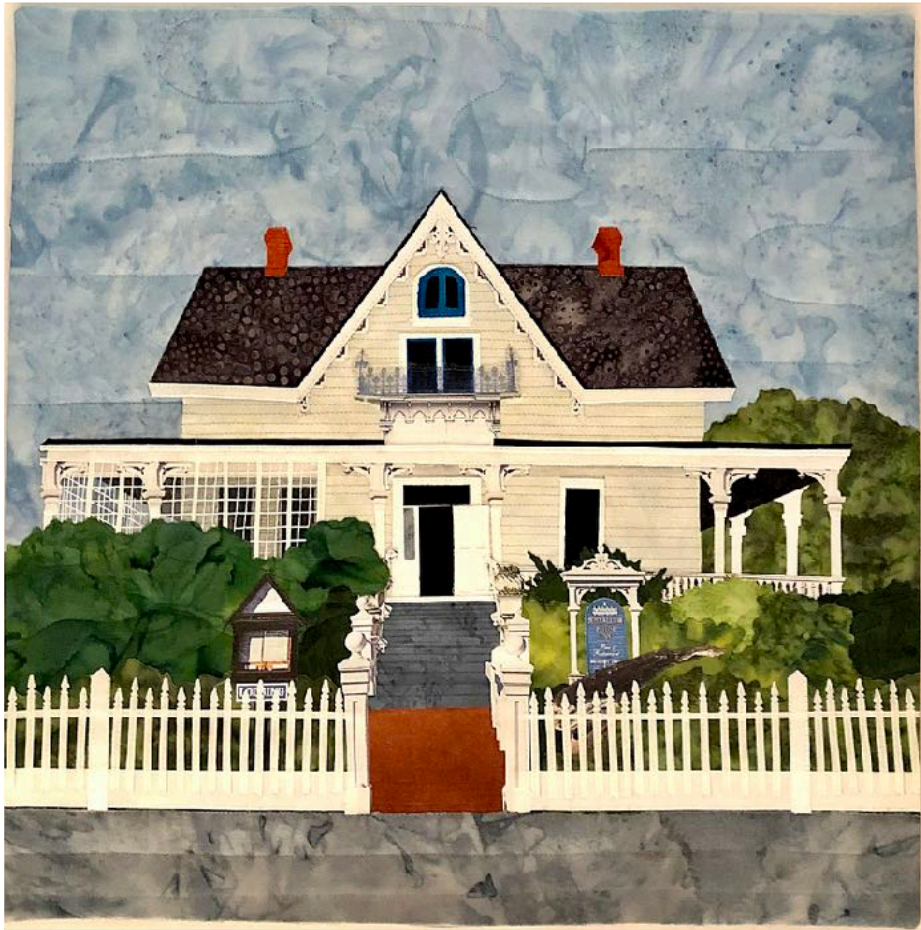

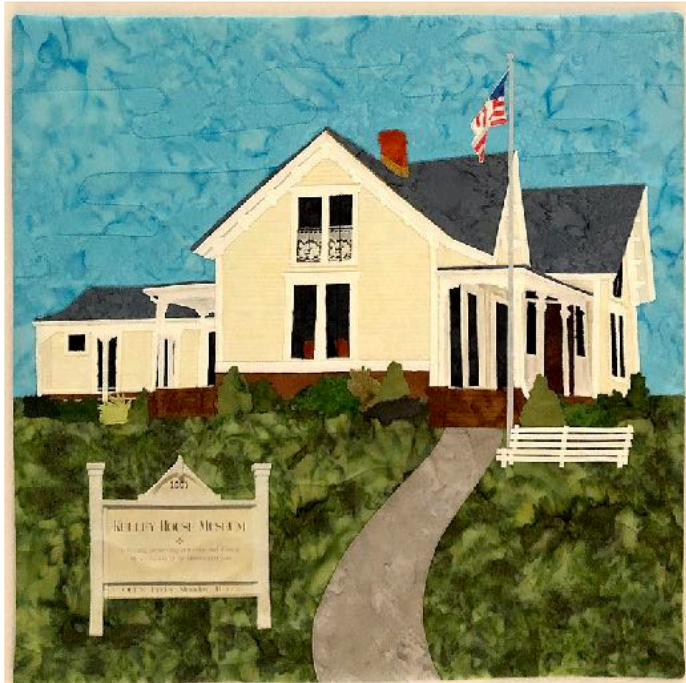
