JARVIS-NICHOLS BUILDING 2
(Now Gallery Bookshop)

This building may have been built in 1874. In 1881, it was the Jarvis and Nichols Mercantile. Henry Jarvis, a native of Maine, was Postmaster of Mendocino from 1877 to 1885. He ran a store with Thomas Dollard and later with James A. Nichols, continuing until 1916. The Wilson Hotel used to be in the same building, and John Barry's barber shop/home was next door.



HIGHLIGHT GALLERY 3
(Until its recent move...)

Built around 1874, in 1881 this was the barber shop of John A. Barry with his home upstairs. Next door was the first Brown & Gray Mercantile (which later moved down Main Street to the corner of Lansing and Main – currently the Whistlestop).
