Meeting called to order by Paula P at 12:35 pm. Paula asked if all members present had their COVID vaccination card on file. Everyone agreed.

Block of the Month Demonstration: Catherine S presented “Turn About”. It is a block with a half-square triangle and a rectangle, repeated 4 times. I will not include the pattern because of accuracy concerns. Catherine’s directions presented a template that is precise. Contact her if you would like to participate. She wants the colors to be “warm”. Not browns. Use off white for one color. Orange, Reds, etc. The block is 11 ½” finished.

Tip of the Month: Tina P shared that the colors on your phone are not accurate. She took a picture of some purple fabric and went to Sew n Sew to get a different value.
