Thank you so very much. Attached here is a fun pic of the proud artist with your iconic quilt.

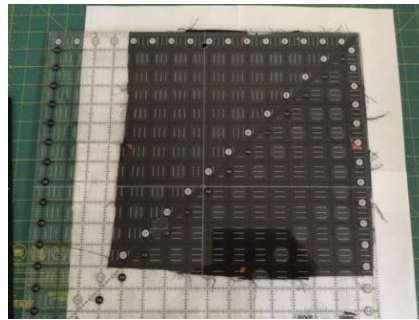

I would like to offer this “Tip of the Month” to help us all in particular when we piece our monthly Blocketts. This is a picture of a prior monthly Blockette that should have measured 12 ½ square.



No matter what project you are working on, these tips will help us.

10 Quilt Piecing Tips & Tricks to Improve Piecing Accuracy

Everyone wants to make accurate quilt blocks, so here are 10 tips to help. These tips and tricks are by “A Quilting Life”.

1. Sew with an Accurate 1/4” Seam Allowance. Do a test by cutting 3, 1 1/2” x 3” strips. Sew them together. It should measure 3 1/2” square when sewn.
2. Use Proper Pressing Techniques, never iron, minimize the steam!
3. A Good Iron is Essential
4. Press Fabrics Before Cutting; spray with your favorite brand of starch.
5. Accurate Measuring & Cutting Methods
6. Carefully Read Pattern Instructions
7. Make a Test Block
8. Size up and trim down where possible like HST, QST, flying geese
9. Have fun!
