

**Abbreviations:**

HST - Half-Square Triangles  
FG - Flying Geese  
WOF - Width of Fabric  
BG - Background

**Cloth needed:**

1- 12" X 12" background which is provided..

**From your stash**

1 3" x 12" dark brown color. This will be color D

1 3" x 12" reddish color. This will be color C

1 3" x 30" (or 6" x 15") blue-green color. This will be color A

1 3" x 30" (or 6" x 15") very light tan or similar color. This will be color B

1 3"x 12" black or close to black color. This will be the color BLK

**Cut the following pieces:**

1: From the large square of background fabric cut 3 strips 2-1/2" x WOF them from each strip cut 4 2-1/2" squares. Set aside

2: From the strip of background fabric which is left over cut 4 3" squares. Set aside.

3: From the dark brown color cut 4 3" squares. Set aside

4: From the reddish color cut 4 2-1/2" squares. Set aside

5: From the blue-green color cut 4 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangles and cut 4 2-1/2" squares. Set aside

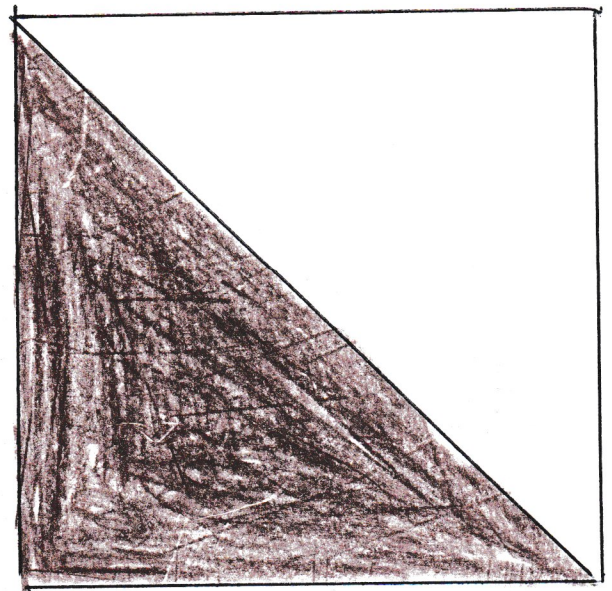
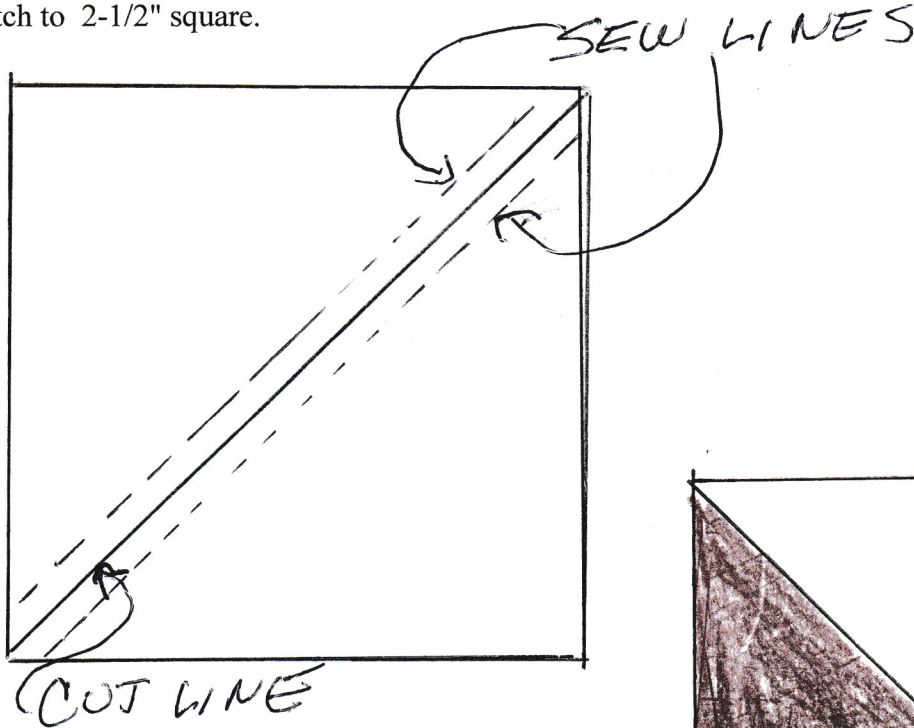
6. From very light tan(or similar color) cut 4 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangles and cut 4 2-1/2" squares. Set aside

7: From black color cut 4 2-1/2" squares. Set aside

**Assembly of the HST and FG. When sewing these parts sew slowly:**

**Make the HST with the following method:**

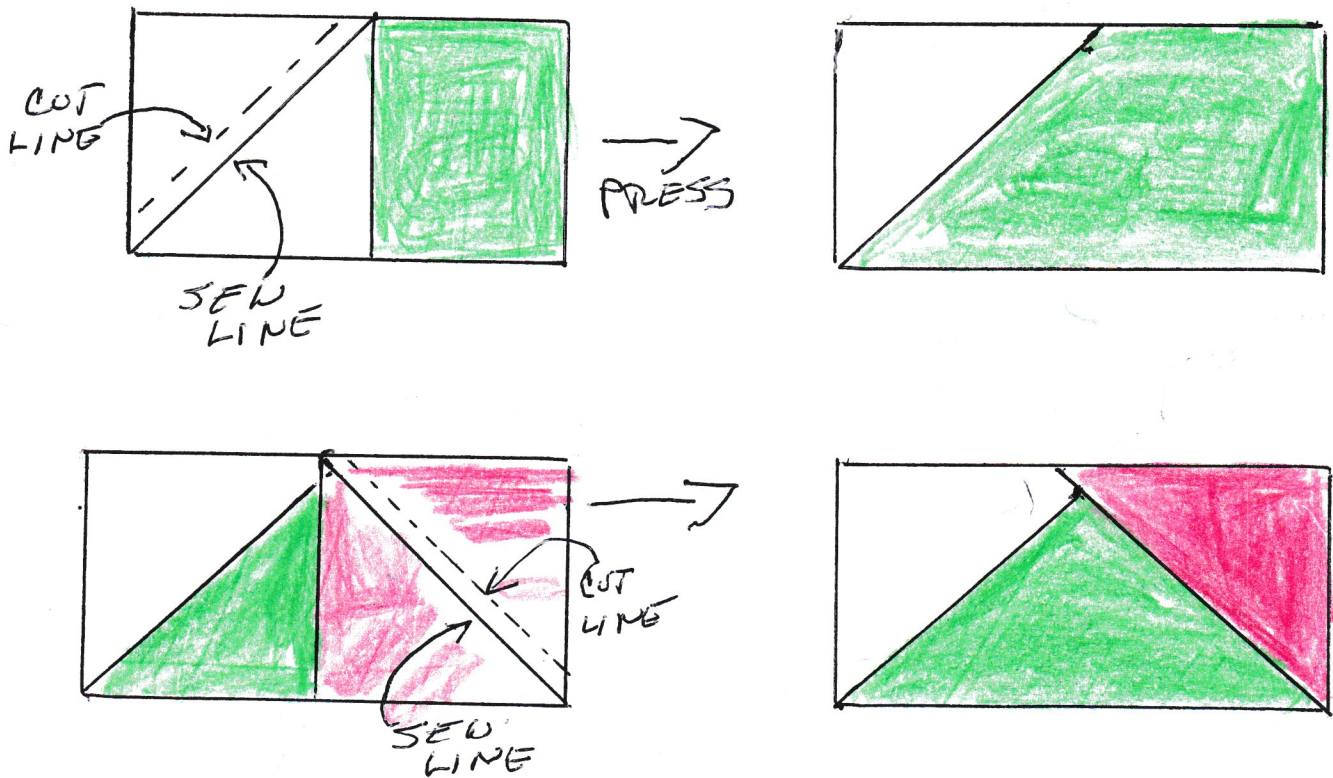
On the back of a dark brown square and draw a line so that you can see it (best done with a chalk pencil) corner to corner. Take one of the 3" squares of background fabric and put these two pieces face to face. Sew a 1/4" seam on each side of this line as shown below. Carefully cut on along the corner to corner line and press the seam towards the darker color. Then square up the patch to 2-1/2" square.

**Make the FG with the following instructions:**

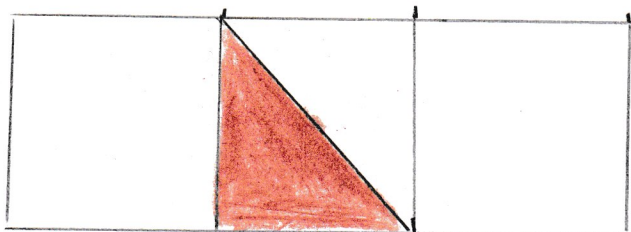
When looking at a "Flying Geese" patch, there are two side triangles surrounding a larger middle triangle. I will refer to the left hand "wing" and to the right hand "wing" as if you were looking at it from the right side of the rectangle. Get one of the blue-green rectangles and place it face up. Get a tan 2-1/2" square, draw a diagonal line corner to corner on the wrong side and place it on the right hand side of the rectangle with the diagonal line showing and going top to bottom from right to left as shown below. Sew along the outside edge of your line and then trim 1/4" to the outside of the line as shown below. Get a red 2-1/2" square, draw a diagonal line as above, and place this "wing" on the right side of the triangle, again (it will overlap the first "wing" with the diagonal line going from upper left to lower right). Sew and trim as above. Finish the other three of this color then assemble the other 4 geese using the light tan rectangle with a 2 1/2" blue-green triangle for the left side and a black 2 1/2" square on the right side.



**Unit Assembly (all seams are 1/4"):**

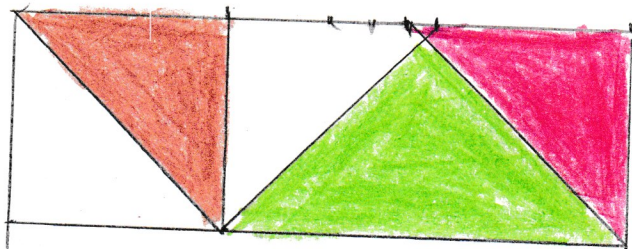
**Make row 1 from left to right as follows:**

One background square sewn to one HST with the background color the on the right. Then another background square place on the right. Finished row as below. Make 4 strips like this. One for each unit.



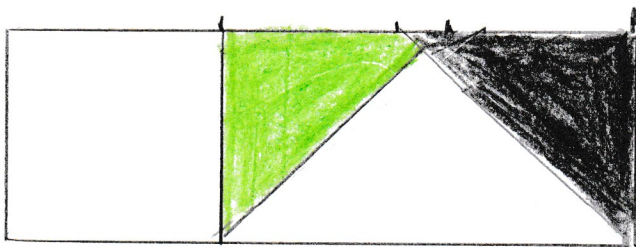
**Make row 2 from left to right as follows:**

Sew one HST with the background color to the lower right to the FG with the red right hand "wing". Finished row as below. Make 4 strips like this. One for each unit.



**Make row 3 from left to right as follows:**

Sew one HST with the background color to the lower right to the FG with the black right hand "wing". Finished row as below. Make 4 strips like this. One for each unit.



Repeat the above for units 2, 3, 4.

**Assemble Units (seams are 1/4"):**

Take 2 units and place next to each other in the same orientation. Turn the right hand unit 90 degrees to the right and sew together. Repeat with the other two units. Then take these units and place one below the other and turn the lower unit 180 degrees to the right and sew both units together as shown on the last page. Please do not square up block.
