

Tulip Block

Block will be 9½" (finishes to 9")

NOTE: Pictures show a blue background... please use WHITE instead. Make it a WHITE WHITE, not a cream. White on white is fine.

From white fabric, cut:

- two 4½" squares
- two 3½" squares
- two 3¼" squares
- two 2¼" squares

From green for the leaves and stem, cut:

- one 4½" square
- one 3½" square

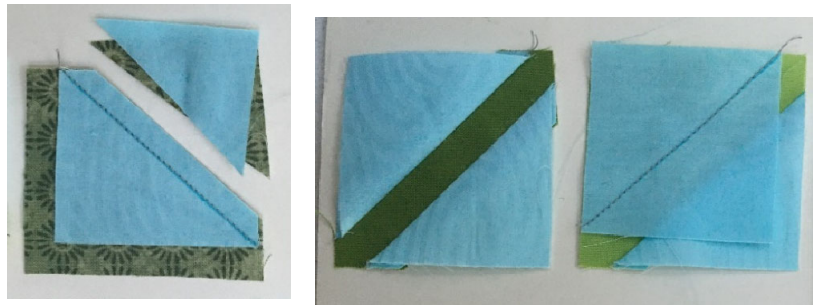
From pastel for the flower, cut:

- one 4½" square
- one 3½" square

From two complementary/coordinating colors, cut:
each 2¼" square of each

Stem square

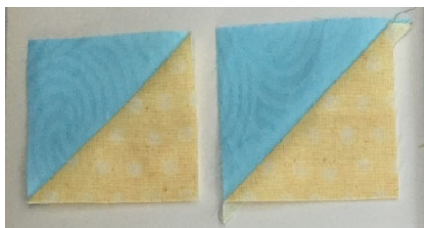
Draw a diagonal on the wrong side of both white 3¼" squares. Place a light blue 3¼" square and the green 3½" square, right sides together and sew on the diagonal. Trim to ¼". Press to the white. Repeat on the opposite corner. Square to 3½".



Leaves and flower HSTs

Draw a diagonal on the wrong side of both of the white 4½" squares.

Put a white square and a 4½" green square right sides together. Sew ¼" on both the right and left sides of the diagonal. Cut on the diagonal. Press away from the white side. Square to 3½".



Repeat with the white and flower 4½" squares.

4-patch

Sew a 4-patch using the white 2¼" squares and the 2¼" coordinating colored squares. Square to 3½".



9-Patch

Finally, sew together all 9 squares to make the tulip block. It should measure 9½" x 9½". Don't trim it.
