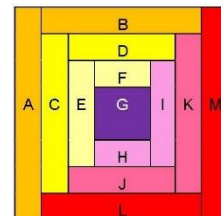

Your job will be to follow printed directions to color the pin pieces, glue them to a pre-cut back, and attach the stick-on pin clasp!
