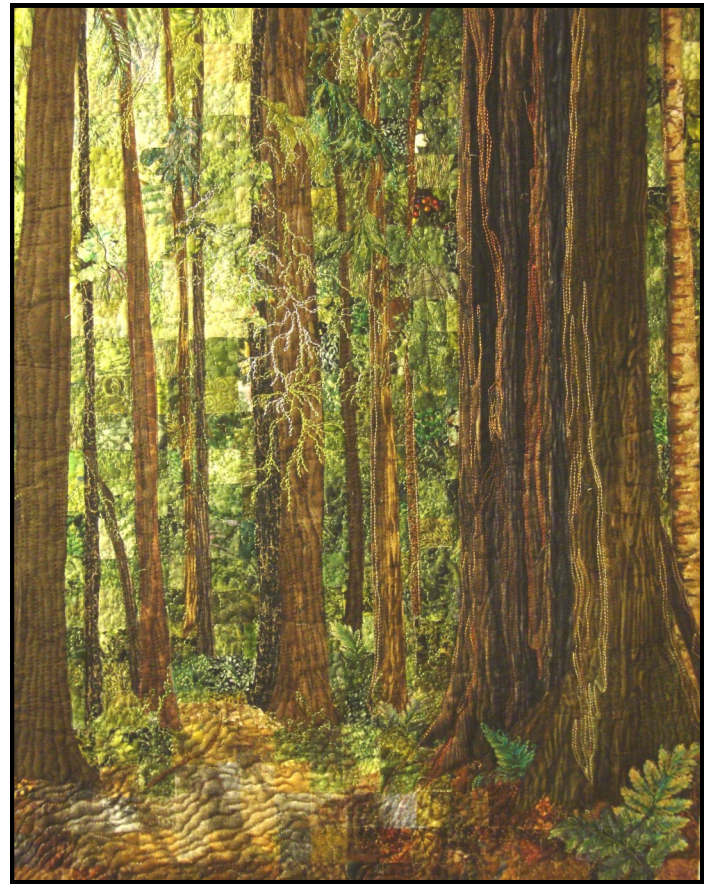

Class materials required for 25x20" wall hanging

Pat will provide: 8 x10" inspiration forest picture with grid

Bring:

- ➔ • Quilter's Grid 1" – 5/8 yard (*fusible interfacing with printed grid*)
- ➔ • Plain white paper 24x28 (like clean newsprint, white wrapping paper, or butcher paper—no wax)
- Fabrics of many kinds and values— **CUT 1 1/4" squares**

Fabrics for trees will be cut in strips (wait for class)

Opt. Special fabrics like ferns, flowers, animals fussy cut for overlay.

You will probably have some fabrics in your stash- .

!! (recommended) If you do some cutting before class you will have a head start—cut squares 1 1/4". We will start at the bottom, dirt is what you need to cut first. You will need only small pieces of the various fabrics--the more variety of fabrics you use, the more interesting your quilt will be. The fabrics may have prints on them, if the look is right, tone on tones, and batiks work great too. You might want to share fabrics with a friend to get more variety in the color groups.

The trees are done in strips—not squares— best to use several different browns or blacks for your trees. (wait to cut them)

Color areas	Several fabrics of each color	1 1/4" Pcs
Sky light blue or white	Minimal	40
Light green prints	1/4 yd total	200
Dark green prints	1/4 yd total	200
(ground) Tans and browns	1/3 yd total	150
Trees: Dark Brown and black prints	Strips for trees (don't cut)
