

Block of the Month for July 2025

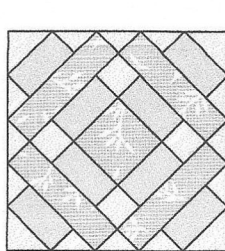

Cutting instructions (note: Use Best Press or starch before cutting!):

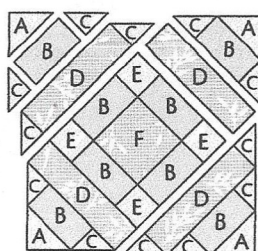
1. From background fabric, cut one strip $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF.
2. From this strip cut three $3\frac{3}{4}$ " squares. Cut each diagonally in half two times. These are your **C** triangles.
3. From the same background fabric strip, cut two $3\frac{3}{8}$ " squares. Cut each diagonally in half one time. These are your **A** triangles.
4. From the same background fabric strip, cut one $4\frac{1}{2}$ " square. Subcut this into four $2\frac{1}{4}$ " squares. These are your **E** pieces.
5. From any of your fabrics, cut a strip $2\frac{1}{4}$ " x WOF. From this, cut eight rectangles $2\frac{1}{4}$ " x 4 ". These are your **B** pieces.
6. From another of your fabrics, cut a strip $2\frac{1}{4}$ " x WOF. From this, cut four rectangles $2\frac{1}{4}$ " x $7\frac{1}{2}$ ". These are your **D** pieces.
7. From your feature fabric, cut one 4 " square. This is your **F** piece.

Putting it together:

8. Attach a **C** triangle to each side of a **B** rectangle as shown. Trim as needed and press toward **B**. Add an **A** triangle as shown to form an **ACBC** corner piece. Press toward **A**. Make four **ACBC** units and set aside two.
9. Attach a **C** triangle to each end of a **D** rectangle as shown to form a **CDC** unit. Trim as needed and press toward **D**. Make two of these and set aside.
10. Attach a **CDC** unit to an **ACBC** unit. Press toward **CDC**. Make two of these units. These are **large corner pieces**.
11. Attach a **D** rectangle to an **ACBC** unit. Press toward **D**. Make two of these **DACBC** units. These are **small corner pieces**.
12. Attach an **E** square to each end of a **B** rectangle as shown to form an **EBE** unit. Press toward **B**. Make two of these and set aside.
13. Attach a **B** rectangle to one side of the **F** square. Attach another **B** rectangle to the opposite side to form a **BFB** unit. Press both toward **B**.
14. Sew an **EBE** unit to each side of the **BFB** unit. Press toward **BFB**.
15. Sew a **small corner piece** to opposite sides of the large rectangle. Press toward **D**.
16. Sew a **large corner piece** to the other sides of the rectangle. Press toward **CDC** and you're finished!
