

Hello Mendocino Rotary,

The Community Services Board met before the regular speaker meeting on Thursday, June 15th at 11:30am. In attendance were Margaret Black, Jeff Stubbs, Toby Wade, and the lovely Leona Walden.

Our agenda was to strategize moving forward and ways to get the word out to the community for submitting proposals. Two proposals that had been previously received were presented.

- Peter Gealey of the Noyo Yoyo Petanque Club for an upgrade/resurfacing of the petanque court. This proposal was put at the top of the list after our last meeting. The proposal was for \$2000. It was suggested during the meeting that we reach out to Peter and ask about splitting the cost and the possibility of permanent Rotary signage at the courts.
- Paul Davis from the Mendocino Coast Hospitality Center submitted a proposal on April 3rd stating their need for an additional \$20,000 for replacing a section of their exterior siding. So far, they had raised \$40,000 of the \$60,000 that is needed to complete the project. We will circle back to check the status.

We are waiting to confirm our budget for the 2024 year. This will be determined after our July Board meeting. Margaret will be reaching out to both Peter Gealy and Paul Davis. These proposals as well as any others that are received will be discussed at our next Community Services meeting on July 27th at 11:30am.
