Equipment

Warm winter clothing, ski jacket and trousers, thermal underwear, gloves, ski goggles or sunglasses, ski or snowboard, ski boots or snowboard boots, and a ski helmet.

Rental & Ski Schools

Ski and snowboard equipment can be rented in Gudauri from approximately 25 EUR per day.

Private and group ski lessons are available from approximately 30 EUR per hour.

Optional Winter Experiences

Our experienced mountain guide will be happy to recommend and organise optional winter experiences according to weather conditions, snow conditions and participants' interests.

- On-piste: Alpine skiing, snowboarding and ski lessons.
- Off-piste: Freeriding, ski touring, snowshoe hiking, snowmobile tours, tandem paragliding and heli-skiing.
- Excursions: Stepantsminda, Gergeti Trinity Church and the famous Rooms Hotel Kazbegi.

Day 1 – Arrival

Arrival at Tbilisi International Airport.
Transfer to your hotel and check-in.
The remainder of the day is at leisure. Participants arriving early are warmly invited to join an informal gathering in a traditional Georgian wine bar, offering the perfect opportunity to meet fellow Rotarians over a first glass of Georgian wine.

Overnight stay at a hotel in Tbilisi.



Day 2 – Tbilisi & Welcome Fellowship Dinner

After breakfast, participants gather for a welcome coffee, where everyone has the opportunity to introduce themselves before beginning the journey together.
The programme continues with a guided city tour through Georgia's vibrant capital. Discover the charming Old Town, Narikala Fortress, the famous sulphur bath district and Rustaveli Avenue while learning about the country's rich history and culture.
In the evening, enjoy a traditional Georgian dinner together with local Rotarians. This relaxed

fellowship evening provides an excellent opportunity to exchange ideas, establish new friendships and experience Georgian hospitality.

Day 3 – Gudauri Ski Resort

After breakfast, transfer to Gudauri Ski Resort via the spectacular Georgian Military Highway. Upon arrival, check in to your hotel and enjoy your first afternoon on the slopes or relax in the hotel's spa and wellness facilities. The evening is free to settle into the mountain atmosphere and enjoy dinner together.

Day 4–7 Gudauri Ski Resort & Surroundings

Days 4 to 7 are dedicated to skiing and enjoying the spectacular winter landscapes of the Greater Caucasus. Participants are free to explore the ski resort at their own pace or simply relax and enjoy the mountain atmosphere. A wide range of optional winter activities and scenic excursions can be arranged throughout the stay according to weather conditions, snow conditions and participants' interests. The evenings are dedicated to informal fellowship, offering plenty of time to enjoy Georgian cuisine, share Rotary experiences and build lasting international friendships.

Day 8 – Departure

After breakfast, transfer to Tbilisi International Airport according to your flight schedule. Guests wishing to extend their stay may either remain in Gudauri for additional skiing days or be transferred to a hotel in Tbilisi for further individual sightseeing or onward travel.

Ski Resort

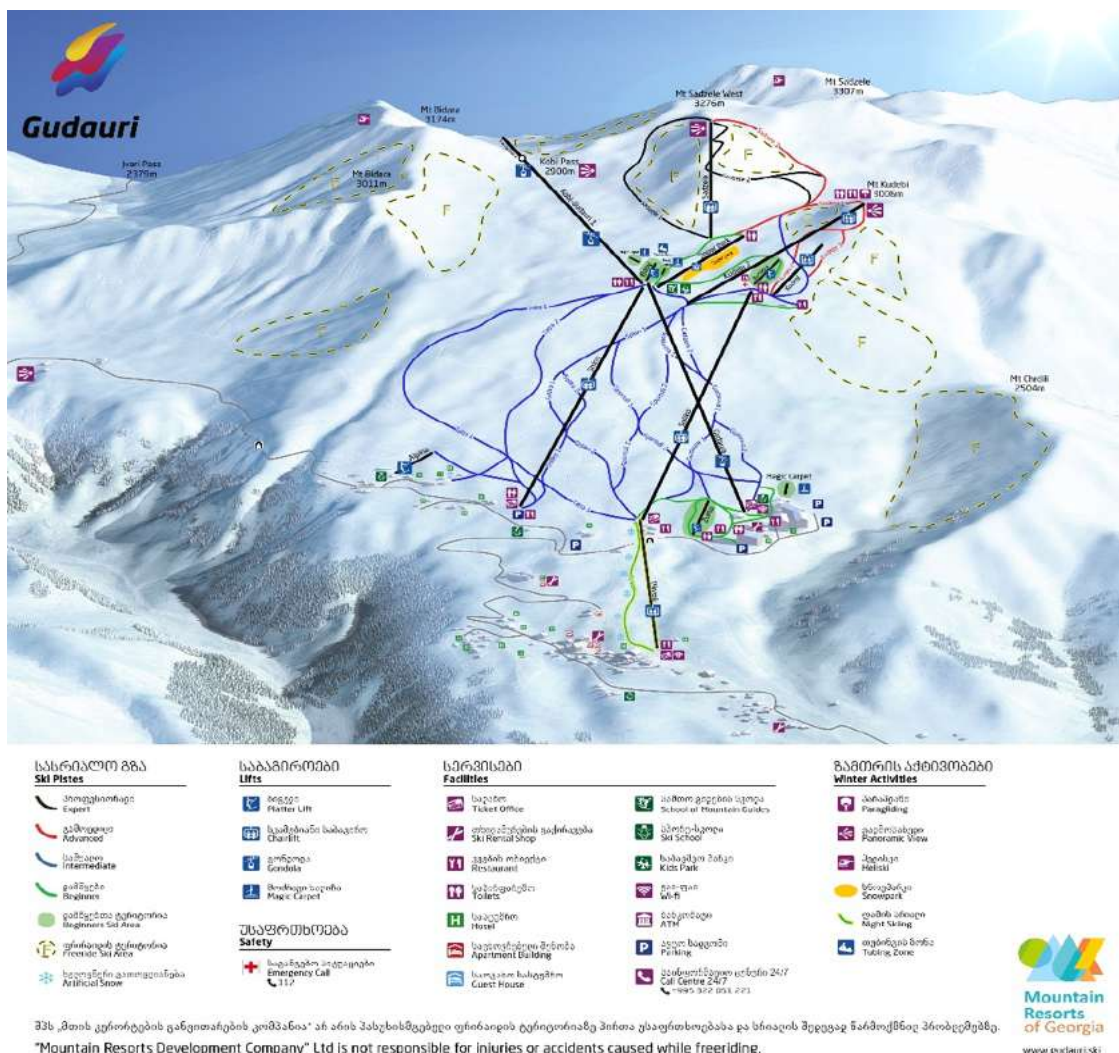
The Gudauri Ski Resort is located approximately two hours' drive from Tbilisi and is the largest ski resort in Georgia. It features 34.4 km of groomed ski slopes and approximately 40 km of accessible off-piste and freeride terrain above the tree line. With elevations ranging from 1,993 m to 3,276 m, the resort offers excellent snow conditions throughout the winter season

1. ■ Beginners - 1.9 km
2. ■ Easy - 3.4 km
3. ■ Intermediate - 18.8 km
4. ■ Difficult - 10.3 km

For quick and safe transport to the slopes, 15 comfortable ski lifts operate daily from 10:00 to 16:30.

- 4 Ten-person gondola
- 4 Six-person chairlift
- 1 Single person chairlift
- 2 Three-person chairlift
- 4 Platter lift (t-bar)
