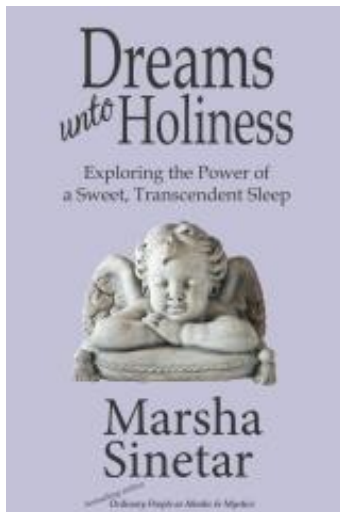

“An Exchange of Selves”

Thomas Merton called dialogue “an exchange of selves,” and few subjects draw out that posture more than talking about dreams, and spiritual dreams, all the more.

Perhaps some, or much, of the unrest we see in society today is due to the alienation many feel *because* of the impersonal nature of technology and its influence on everything: home, family, work, community, health care and so on.

Perhaps a little more “exchange of selves” might soften the blow of rapid social and technological change. Although, from what I’m learning, we “ain’t seen nothing yet.” So let us keep one another in prayer.
