The Krenov Foundation Award for Professional Development - \$2500

Awarded to an emerging fine woodworking professional to assist them as an artist in residence or visiting scholar at a nationally recognized Woodworking School or Arts and Crafts Center.

Application Requirements

1. Resume
2. A minimum of 4 years of experience as a woodworking professional
3. Statement of Purpose i.e. what do you hope to accomplish during your residency and how will it assist you in achieving your long term goals as a professional woodworker (1 page maximum)
4. Brief financial summary justifying the need for financial assistance.
5. A minimum of one and preferably two Letters of Recommendation that address the applicant's skill level and commitment to the woodworking profession
6. Digital photographs of at least 3 woodworking projects or pieces of furniture that demonstrate the skill level and craftsmanship of the applicant.

Yearly Application Window

1. Applications accepted from May 1-31 of each year
2. Scholarship Committee Review and Recommendation by June 30
3. If no qualified applicant is identified from the May applications, additional applications will be considered as received until a qualified applicant is identified.

Selection Criteria

- Financial Need - 25%
- Letter(s) of Recommendation - 15%
- Demonstrated Craftsmanship/Talent - 30%
- Relevance of Residency to Professional Goals - 30%
